ETNDR development – new structure

Project PROM-ET DR (Promotion of Environmental Technology in the Danube Region)

- Danube Region size and complexity require country representatives for the ETNDR
- Funding to continue the ETNDR necessary
- as part of the Transnational Cooperation / INTERREG is created a new structure - Project PROM ET DR:
 - integrate players and partners
 - develop know-how solutions together and bring to the application
 - set up eight "Centers of Practice" (CPs) in AU, BG, CZ, DE, HU, HR, RO, RS
 - focus on waste and water management
- project duration at least 3-5 years, additional staff capacity required
