The presentation will not focus solely on project and investment values. It will also assess the engineering, technology, manufacturing, equipment and materials, EPC/EPCM, procurement, supply chain and financing requirements created by large-scale investments across sectors.

One sector's investment is another sector's order. The objective is to identify not only where global investment will take place, but also which companies and sectors can capture the business volume those investments generate.
